Warning:

- 1. If you have any checking/savings accounts at Wells Fargo Bank you should transfer the money to another bank prior to filing bankruptcy since they put a hold on accounts if you file bankruptcy and your money will be tied up until the Trustee releases the money. This is the only bank which does this. Please tell me if you have a Wells Fargo Bank account.
- 2. If you have any checking/savings accounts at a bank/credit union where you also owe them money on a debt, you should also transfer most, but not all, of the money out of that account to an account at a bank where you don't owe money. Please tell me if you have this situation.
- 3. Don't make any other transfers without first discussing them with me. You normally don't want to transfer any property prior to filing bankruptcy since this could prevent a discharge. Example: You have a car in your name. Don't transfer this car to anyone else prior to filing bankruptcy.
